## RICHARD HAAS

Born in Spring Green, Wisconsin in 1936, Haas received a BA in Art and Art Education from the University of Wisconsin/Milwaukee and an MFA from the University of Minnesota. Haas has had a distinguished career in teaching, art administration, painting and printmaking. He is known particularly for his murals and large-scale trompe l'oeil paintings.

The list of exhibitions and commissions that have been awarded to Haas is seemingly endless. In the past ten years, Haas has designed and executed murals in numerous locations ranging from the Lincoln Tunnel Exit in New York City to the Garden Entrance Alcove of the Wentworth Melbourne Hotel in Melbourne, Australia.

Awards for Haas' architectural imagery have come from the Municipal Arts Society of New York, American Institute of Architecture, National Endowment for the Arts, and he has also received the John Simon Guggenheim Memorial Fellowship.

One-person exhibitions featuring Richard Haas' work have been mounted at the Whitney Museum of American Art, San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, the American Institute of Architects Foundation, the Chrysler Museum, the St. Louis Art Museum, and the Aspen Art Museum to name a few.
